

## 10 must-see exhibitions in Hong Kong this September 2018

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This September, Kawaii art is popping up all over, whether it be in Phillips Auctions' celebration of colour at its selling exhibition this month or at Perrotin's solo show by Mr. While some exhibitions contend with skewing the viewer's perception and emotion, others present important artistic stalwarts that have stood the test of time. Here are our favourite must-see art exhibitions in Hong Kong this month.


### **Kathryn Andrews**


**14 September to 26 October**



Sweets, magic eight-balls and other shiny, happy objects appear larger than life at this new solo show at Simon Lee Gallery. Influenced by the visual contradictions of pop art and minimalism, while experimenting with the sheen of mirror finishes on banal objects, Andrews creates art that emphasises each depicted object's own inherent seductive "thingness." A polished piece of stainless steel is attached perpendicularly to the flat plane, introducing the viewer's reflection in every piece, and is a way for the artist to invite and manipulate renewed awareness of our surroundings and the way we perceive sculpture.
